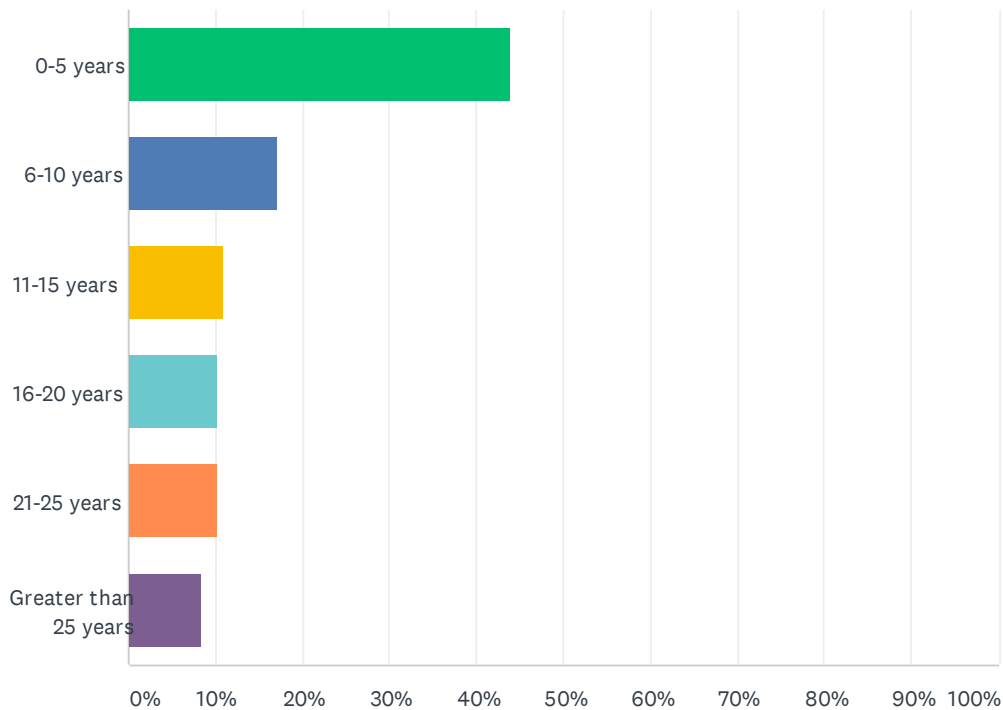


Q1 1. How long have you been associated with All Saints parish?

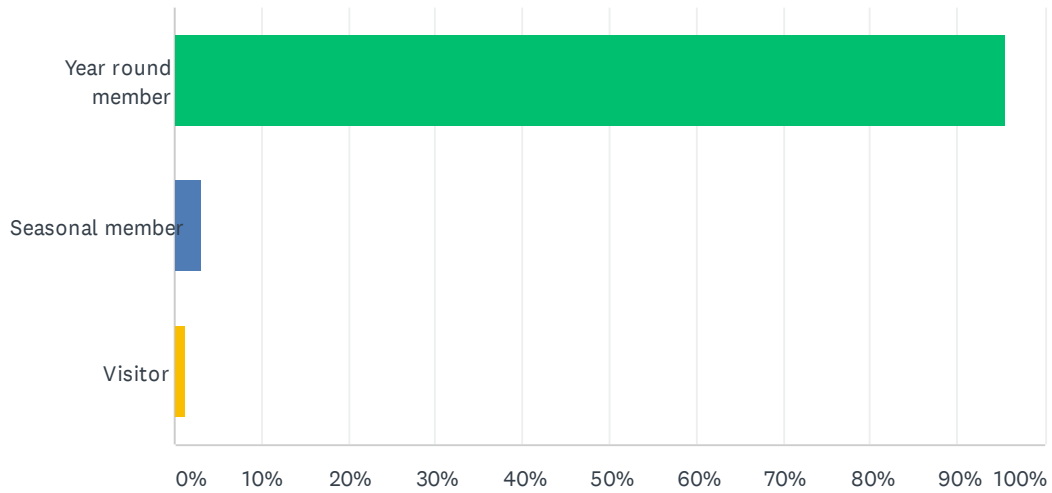

Q2 2. Are you:

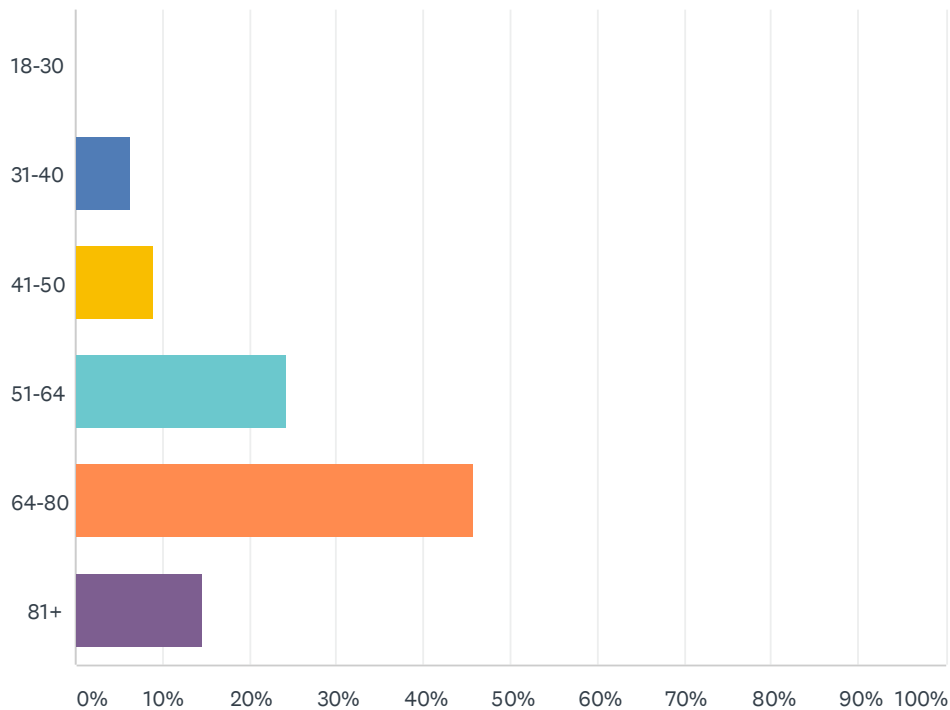

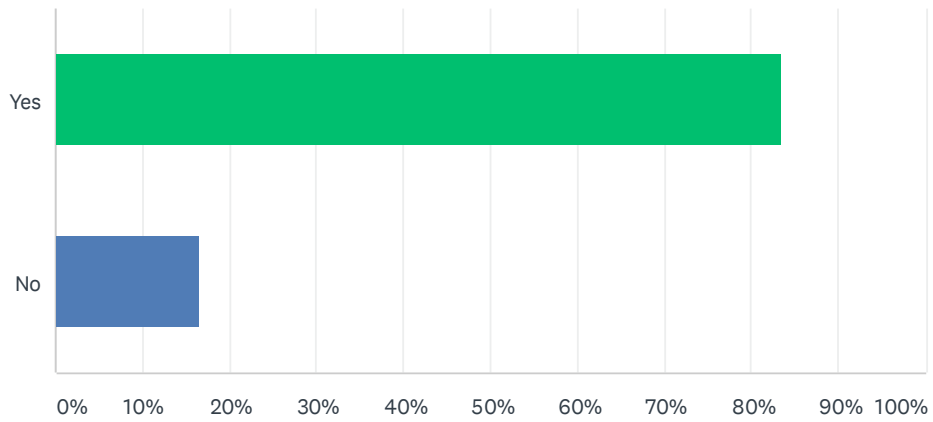
